



## 2023-24 Kindergarten Supply List

---

The supplies in this section are items each student needs to bring to school, as general office supplies.

- 2 packs **EXPO** markers, (8 or more)
- 3 reams white copy paper
- 1 pack **Scotch** tape
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 boxes **Clorox/Lysol** wipes
- 3 boxes **Kleenex** tissues
- 1 pack Quart sized **Ziploc** bags

Each student also has a list of personal supplies they will need in their classroom.

- 2 boxes **Ticonderoga** #2 pencils (12 count), sharpened with erasers
- 1 pencil box/pouch (hard top preferred for grades K - 4)(student's choice for grades 5 – 12)
- 1 pack **Crayola** colored pencils, sharpened with no erasers
- 2 boxes **Crayola** crayons (32 count)
- 2 boxes **Crayola** Broad Line markers (10 count)
- 1 **Crayola** 8-count Watercolor Paints with brush
- 3 large **Elmer's** glue sticks
- 8-ounce **Elmer's** glue bottle
- 1 spiral-bound notebook
- 1 yellow folder (with 3 brads)
- 1 red folder (with 3 brads)
- 1 green folder (with 3 brads)
- 1 Primary journals (top half blank for drawing, bottom half lined for writing) Example: <https://bit.ly/3Z27oyd>
- 1 pair scissors (blunt tip for grades K-2)(make sure it will fit your child's hand for grades 3 – 12)
- 1 lunch bag/box with ice packs (no refrigeration provided at school) [Label with student's name]
- Water bottle (reusable with leak proof lids) [Label with student's name]
- Backpack [Label with student's name]
- Items needed for PE Class
  - Running Shoes/Tennis Shoes [The PE teacher recommends low heel rise shoes.] Students will be running every PE class, even if it is raining (exception when it is lightning).
- **Personal Items for Students:**
  - School shoes must have Velcro fastening [Please do not have students in tie shoes]
  - Small blanket (and pillow if desired) for naptime

- 1 change of clothes [Please label each piece of clothing and put in Ziploc bag (shirt, pants, underwear, and socks). Non-uniform items are acceptable.]
- 1 pair of rain boots
- Mittens (not gloves!!) and mitten clips
